Gotta Love a Series

To Play:

Find something small to use as a token to move around the board. Start on the purple Cat's Corner box (lower left corner). Roll a single 6-sided die (if you don't have a die, use 6 playing cards, random number generator, make numbers to draw from a cup, etc.) Move your token the number of spaces shown by the die in a clockwise rotation. Read a book that fits the prompt given on the space you landed. To determine your next book/prompt, roll the die and continue from your current space.

Remember, this is just a game! Have fun ... no one is watching if you want to fudge a prompt or see an extra dot on the die where one isn't, it's okay. Some of the prompts on the board are self-explanatory (I think) but some of them require me to do some explaining (below). Again, if you don't like the prompt, or you don't have a book that fits the prompt, then pick a different one. It's totally okay ... Catsby is not a very good "guard cat" and will not notice anyway!

The Prompts:

What Does that Emoji Mean – Go to <https://perchance.org/emoji>, hit the "randomize" button and read a book that pertains to the emoji that comes up. For example, if an apple emoji is shown, you could pick a book with an apple on the cover, the word "apple" in the title, the author or a character could be named Apple, maybe apple makes you think of apple pies which make you think of fall and there is a tree on the cover of the book with fall-colored leaves, etc. You get the point? Whatever you think of when you see the emoji! You don't have to rationalize it to anyone ... Catsby is not going to test you later!

Friend or Family Pick – Have someone else pick a book for you. If it would make it easier, give them a list of books you already own and/or want to read and have someone pick from that.

The Cover Made Me Do It – Read a book because you liked or were intrigued by the cover.

Light vs. Dark – If you rolled an even number to get to this space, read a book that is light in color, or light in topic. If you rolled an odd number to get to this space, read a book that is dark in color, or has darker themes.

Holiday Themed Book – Whatever holiday is closest to the time you are playing this game, read a book related to that holiday. For example, if you are playing this game in October, you may pick a Halloween themed book. If you are reading this book in July, you may pick a book themed in summer or around Independence Day.

Favorite Genre, Topic, or Trope – Read a book in your favorite genre, or about a topic you find interesting.

And the Winner Is – Read a book that has won an award ... any award ... from anywhere!

Borrowed Book – Read any book from the library, kindle unlimited, or borrowed from another person.

Reader's Choice – There are two of these spaces on the board. If you land on either one, you can choose any book you want to read, use any of the prompts already on the board, or maybe draw a title from a list of books you already own. Remember, it is your choice!

Favorite Author – Read a book by one of your favorite authors.

Non-fiction – This non-fiction book can be on any topic you choose (biography, memoir, self-help, true crime, sports, health, etc.)

Non-human Characters – Read a book that contains any characters that are not human; monsters, mermaids, vampires, animals, ghosts, or any inanimate objects that you may determine to be a character in the story such as houses, plants, cars, etc.

Color Wheel Pick – Go to <https://spinthewheel.app/wheel-of-colors> , spin the wheel, and read a book whose cover matches the color chosen. Feel free to edit the wheel to add or take away colors. You could also create a wheel with book titles instead of colors to choose your next read.

Less Than 300 Pages – Read a small novel, short story, kid’s book, comic/manga ... anything that is less than 300 pages.

Comfort Book – Read a book that makes you comfortable, or that you find comfort in; a book that you know you are going to love; something you would like to curl up with under a blanket drinking cocoa while it’s raining outside.

Gotta Love a Series – Read a book that is part of a series. You can start a new series, continue a series, or read that last book that has been on your list forever.

Let the Die Choose – Roll the die again (but don’t move your token!) Whatever number you roll, find a book with that many words in the title.

Lions, Tigers, Bears, oh my – Read a book with animals.

Happy Birthday to Me – Read a book that was published in your birthday month (year doesn’t matter).

Favorite Scent or Flavor – Read a book that is somehow connected to your favorite scent or flavor. For example, if your favorite scent is cut grass, then find a book with grass or a lawnmower on the cover, or who has a character that is a landscaper. Just like with the “emoji” prompt, this is how you interpret your favorite scent or flavor, and Catsby is not going to tell you it’s wrong ... I promise!

New-to-you Author – Read a book by an author that you have never read before.

Re-Read – Read a book that you have already read before.

More Than 400 Pages – Read a novel that has more than 400 pages, or you can read a collection of short stories, poems, an omnibus or collection of more than one book by the same or different authors, so long as the one volume has more than 400 pages.

Oldie but a Goodie – Read a book that you have either owned for more than 10 years, or that was published at least 10 years ago.
